ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

A Read entire manual prior to assembly and save for future use.

TO SET UP COMMODE FRAME

- 1 Remove contents from packaging and if any parts are missing or damaged, contact your dealer.
- **2** Lay one Side Frame on a flat surface with the sockets for the Bucket Frame facing up.
- 3 Depress the push pins and Insert the Bucket Frame into the sockets of the Side Frame until the push pins click securely into place. The rear of the Bucket Frame has two tabs that should face up when inserted. The Drop Arm Releases are at the front of the Side Frame.
- 4 Repeat on the other side with the opposite Side Frame.
- **5** Insert the Backrest into back of frame making sure push pins click securely into place.
- 6 Align the clips at the rear of the Commode Seat with the center and press down until the Commode Seat snaps onto the frame. Repeat process with the Commode Lid.

TO INSTALL AND ADJUST LEGS

- Depress the push pin and slide the Lower Leg up or down to desired height until push pin clicks securely into adjustment hole.
- 2 Repeat step 1 for each Leg making sure they are all set to the same height.

TO OPERATE DROP ARMS

- Push Drop Arm Release toward front of commode to lower for easy lateral transfer.
- 2 Reset Drop Arm by raising arm until Drop Arm Release clicks back into place.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

USING AS BEDSIDE COMMODE

- 1 Lift Commode Seat and place Commode Bucket on Support Rails of the Bucket Frame. Then lower Commode Seat for use.
- Place the lid on the Commode Bucket when not in use to contain odor and use the handle on Commode Bucket to remove for cleaning.

USING COMMODE OVER TOILET

- Adjust height, if necessary, and remove the Backest. Then replace the Commode Bucket with the Splash Guard.
- 2 Lift the toilet bowl seat and place the Commode over the toilet centering the Splash Guard directly over the toilet bowl. Then lower Commode Seat for use.

MAINTENANCE

- > Clean after each use with disinfectant.
- > Do NOT use organic solvents, such as acetone or abrasive cleaners.
- > Inspect weekly for wear and to ensure all components are secure. If any component appears worn or is not working properly, contact your dealer for repair and/or replacement parts.

WARRANTY

Limited Lifetime Warranty against manufacturing defects.
